CLUBHOUSE RULES

Member guests

Members are very welcome to invite guests to the Club. Please ensure that your guest(s) sign in.

Persons under 18 years of age

A person under the age of 18 years:

- may enter the bar and restaurant areas, provided they are under the supervision of a responsible adult,
- may not be with 1 metre of the bar service areas,
- may not be sold or supplied liquor on the Club's premises,
- may not enter the Club's gaming machine area,
- or may not operate a gaming machine on the Club's premises.

Smoking areas

The Clubhouse is a non-smoking area. Members and their visitors who wish to smoke may do so in the designated areas. Please extinguish and discard cigarette butts in the ashtrays provided. **Smoking in other areas, including outside the front entrance to the Clubhouse is not permitted.**

Locker Rooms

Subject to availability, a golfing member may rent a locker space from the Club on an annual basis with the option to renew each year. It is the member's responsibility to secure the locker and maintain possession of the key. Members will be charged for the replacement of missing keys. Towels are not to be removed from the locker rooms.

Clubhouse – General

The Clubhouse is for all members to relax and enjoy the social activities which complement the great game of golf. Please note that:

- Members must not incite or demonstrate behaviour that is unbecoming of a member of the Club.
- Members are not permitted to enter “Staff Only” areas.
- The Clubhouse premises shall not be used for commercial or work-related purposes, unless with the approval of the Board or the General Manager.
- Outside food and drinks shall not be brought onto the Club’s grounds or premises.

Complaints regarding Club Employees

Members (including Directors) and visitors are not permitted under any circumstance to reprimand an employee of the Club. A member who wishes to lodge a complaint concerning the conduct of a Club employee, should do so in writing and submit it to the General Manager as soon as possible.

DRESS RULES

A suitable standard of dress must be observed by Members and guests at all times on the golf course and in the Clubhouse. The general dress standard is clothing that is neat, clean and tidy. The table below summaries what clothing is and is not acceptable.

MEN – GOLF COURSE

ACCEPTABLE

- Collared sports (or polo) shirts
- T-Shirts without offensive wording/logos
- Skivvies
- Golf shirts with abbreviated collars
- Tailored shorts and trousers
- Cargo shorts
- Socks (including ankle socks)
- Golf shoes with soft spikes
- Clean and tidy sports shoes
- Caps worn with the peak at the front

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Singlets or flannelette shirts
- Tracksuits and overalls
- Stubbies, board shorts or football shorts
- Industrial or work clothing, including high visibility safety clothing
- Clothing with offensive wording/logos
- Football boots, thongs, Ugg-boots or untidy or dirty footwear
- Golf shoes with metal spikes

WOMEN – GOLF COURSE

ACCEPTABLE

- Collared sports shirts
- Blouses and shirts
- Sports shorts, divided skirts, or shorts
- Tailored pants or divided shirts
- Golf shoes with soft spikes

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Tracksuits
- Stretch shorts
- Short shorts
- Sun-tops, singlets or beach wear
- Thongs, untidy or dirty footwear

MEN AND WOMEN – SPORTS BAR (before 6pm)

ACCEPTABLE

- Dress acceptable on the golf course
- Sandals and Slides
- Tracksuits and overalls
- Stubbies, board shorts or football shorts
- Industrial or work clothing including high visibility safety clothing
- Football socks, shorts, gym gear

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- All clothing must be neat and tidy. The following items are NOT permitted:
- Singlets
- Thongs
- Clothing with offensive wording/ logos
- Golf shoes, Football boots or Ugg boots
- Hats, caps or other headwear unless worn for religious reasons

MEN AND WOMEN – SPORTS BAR (after 6pm) and CLUBHOUSE

ACCEPTABLE

- Dress acceptable on the golf course
- Sandals with a full heel strap, casual enclosed shoes, boat shoes without socks and slides
- Tailored waist length shirts may be worn outside slacks or shorts
- Local sporting club uniforms and tracksuits

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- All clothing must be neat and tidy. The following items are NOT permitted:
- As listed above in Sports Bar before 6pm, and
- Flannelette shirts
- Thongs
- Stubbies, board shorts or football shorts
- Industrial or work clothing, including high visibility safety clothing
- Hats, caps or other headwear unless worn for religious reasons

Members and visitors not complying with the dress rules may be asked to leave the Club's premises.

GOLF COURSE

Risk Warning

Golf is a recreational activity that involves a risk that you may suffer harm while playing golf. Particular risks of harm while playing golf include:

- Being hit by a golf ball struck by another person.
- Being hit by a golf club being swung by another person.
- Falling or slipping on an uneven or slippery surface or slope on the golf course.
- Being hit by an object thrown from course machinery.
- Being hit by a golf cart or other vehicle.
- Being hit by lightning or suffering harm during extreme weather.

Calling up on Par 3 holes

It is not compulsory to call up the group behind you, on Par 3 holes. However, you may do so if you believe it will keep the field moving.

If you decide to call up the group behind on a Par 3 hole, all players in your group **must stand behind the screens provided while the players behind are hitting their tee-shots.**

Cancellation or Suspension of Play

If play needs to be cancelled due to the course becoming unplayable or is unsafe to play, the Golf Committee may decide to suspend or abandon play. Members are asked to observe the following signals:

- *One Siren – Suspension of Play*
- *Two Sirens – Resume Play*
- *Three Sirens – Abandon Play*

Members are reminded that:

- Metal spikes are not permitted on the golf course.
- They should carry a sand bucket and fill all their divots with care.
- All pitch marks are to be repaired.
- They should remain outside the blue lines with carts.
- The lowest marker in each group is responsible for the course repair, speed of play and etiquette of all players in that group.

Golf Etiquette

Observing the following golf etiquette will make the game more enjoyable for you and other members.

- 1 Nobody should, move, talk, stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
- 2 No player should play until the players in front are out of his or her range.
- 3 All players should play without delay and move quickly between strokes.
- 4 Players searching for a ball should allow other matches behind to pass. When signalling players behind to pass, the group calling players through should cease playing until the passing group is out of range.
- 5 All players must carry a sand bucket and ensure any divots are immediately filled with sand.
- 6 After playing a bunker shot, players should carefully smooth over all holes and footprints made by them and any nearby made by others with a rake. The rake should be replaced in middle of the bunker parallel to the direction of the play.
- 7 All players must repair any pitch marks they make on a green.
- 8 Players should not walk onto the green until the group in front has putted out.
- 9 Players should ensure that when the flagstick is placed on the green, or replaced in the hole, no damage is done to the green.
- 10 When the result of a hole has been determined, players should immediately leave the putting green.

Pace of Play

The Club has a Pace of Play Policy which requires that:

- The First 4 groups must complete their round in 3 hours and 40 minutes and each group must be no more than 20 minutes behind the group in front.
- The next 5 groups must complete their round in under 4 hours and each group must be no more than 15 minutes behind the group in front.
- All following groups must finish their rounds no more than 12 minutes behind the group in front.
- For any group that exceeds the allowed time gap of the group in front, each player of the respective group will receive a letter or email advising them that they didn't comply with the pace of play policy.
- If you are over 12 minutes behind the group in front on any 2 monitoring stations throughout the course, this is also a non-compliance of the Policy and each player in the group will receive a letter advising them that they didn't comply with the Policy.

A member who receives three Warning Letters in a six-month period, will be required to play at the end of the field for one month.

Note: The Board of Directors may amend this policy throughout the year, please ensure you keep current via Members section of the website - Golf Documents.

All members are encouraged to play "READY GOLF" i.e. by being ready when it is your turn to play and it is safe to do so. READY GOLF means:

- Reporting to the Starter at least 15 minutes before your tee-time.
- Proceeding to the 1st tee area when your group has been called as following the group on the tee.
- Teeing-off as soon as it is safe to do so, even if it's not your honour.
- Having the shorter hitters in your group teeing-off first.
- Marking your scorecard on the next tee while others are teeing-off.
- If you're not sure where your ball has finished, play a provisional ball.
- Move quickly between shots.
- The first player **READY** should play their shot, even if they will play out of order.
- Lining up your putt and getting **READY** to putt while others are putting, where possible.

- Putting out whenever possible – remember soft spikes don't damage the greens the way metal spikes used to.
- On Par 3s and on the 1st green, call up the group behind if it will speed up play, although make sure you take shelter behind a protective screen.

Practice Areas

The following areas have been designated as areas in which members may practise during the times noted:

Practice Nets

Located between the main carpark and the 2nd green. This facility is primarily used as a warm-up area. If you intend using this facility for practice, please give way to competition players.

Putting Green

Located at the north-eastern side of Clubhouse outside the Halfway Bar. Please note that chipping is not permitted to the Putting Green.

Practice Fairway (Limited times)

The practice tee is located adjacent to the 4th tee and may only be used by Members during the following times:

- Afternoons after 4:00pm (6:00pm during daylight saving)
- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday mornings before 7:30am

Practice is not permitted on Saturday, Sundays and Wednesday mornings all divots must be repaired.

Chipping Greens

Located adjacent to the 2nd Fairway. This area must not be used during competition times. The last group of the competition must have completed play of the 4th hole before this area may be used. Please repair all divots and pitch marks.

Located adjacent to the 13th and 14th holes. This area may be used at any time with care and respect for neighbouring properties. Please repair all divots and pitch marks.

COMPETITION PLAY

On-line Timesheets

The Club's competition timesheets can be accessed on-line in the Members section of the Club's web-site: www.northrydegolfclub.com.au

Competition timesheets become available on-line at 6:00pm unless stated otherwise, as follows:

Day of competition	Day timesheet first becomes available
Mondays – Veterans or Full Playing alternate week	Wednesday, 5 days before the competition
Tuesdays Women	Thursday (5pm), 5 days prior competition

Rules relating to tee-times:

- 1 Only two (2) Junior Members (under 18 years of age) are permitted to play in any one group, unless permission has been obtained from the Club Captain.
- 2 Members who are unable to play on the date and time they have chosen should remove their name from the timesheet as soon as possible to allow another member to use the tee-time.
- 3 Subject to the exception noted below, if a Member removes his or her name from a Tee-time, it will be automatically filled by next member on the Waiting List for that competition.
- 4 A Member's name may be removed from a tee-time and replaced with another Member's name (without the tee-time being filled by a person on the waiting list) if a request is made to the Pro Shop by 4:00 pm, two days before the relevant competition.
- 5 A Member should not withdraw on the day of a competition unless exceptional circumstances exist, such as ill-health or last-minute work or family commitments.
- 6 A Member who must withdraw on the day of the competition must notify the Starter as soon as practicable.

- 7 Members who fail to appear on the tee at their allocated time in a regular competition will receive a two (2) week suspension from competition golf. A three (3) week suspension will apply in major events.
- 8 Players withdrawing from a major event for which they have qualified will receive a three (3) week suspension from competition golf.

During special events the Golf Committee may vary the "Competition Fees" at its discretion. All above competition fees are current at the time of printing but may also change at the discretion of the Golf Committee.

Members Social Green Fees:

- Social Green Fee of \$10 applies to bookings made on Thurs - Sat & Sun prior daylight savings times.
- Social Green Fee of \$20 (Inc. Free Drink) applies to social bookings made on Fri prior daylight savings times and \$10 for 9 Hole bookings (no drink).
- Flexible Members Social Green Fees are \$20 weekdays and \$60 weekends.

Marking and Returning Scorecards

- Any playing member of the Club may mark another player's card.
- All cards must be signed by the player(s) and the marker.
- The player and the marker should check that the gross stroke score for each hole is correct.
- All scores must be entered via the MiScore App or into one of the kiosk computers located in the downstairs area of the Clubhouse.
- If using the Kiosk you need to manually enter your scores.

Scoring with MiScore App

- MiScore mobile scoring phone app is for use during competition/handicapping rounds at the Club.
- MiScore is available to download from the App Store for your iPhone or Google Play for android phones.
- Once downloaded search for our club by name "North Ryde Golf Club".
- As a member of North Ryde Golf Club, we cover the cost for members to use this app while playing on our course.
- Your login details are the same as your current access to the North Ryde Golf Club's members web site.
- To start scoring you need to be registered in a competition on the day.
- To begin using the app in a competition, simply select a playing partner in your group to mark for and then continue score entry.
- Score by applying a gross score value for each hole before swiping left to the next hole.
- When all scores are entered, validate the player results with digital signature, these scores must be certified by both the marker and the player's signature in the appropriate app signing area and submit for verification.
- When using the app, we recommend that your phone is fully charged before starting your round. Phone batteries that may not last the full round can be charged using the built-in Cart Chargers and/or a small personal accessory power pack.

Count-backs

Where a tie is to be decided on a count-back, the Australian Count-back System will be used. Where scores for an 18-hole competition are tied, the winner will be decided by:

- The lowest score for the last 9 holes.
- If a tie still exists, the lowest score for the last 6 holes.
- If a tie still exists, the lowest score for the last 3 holes.
- If a tie still exists, then hole by hole from the 18th hole.

MAJOR EVENT CONDITIONS

Except where indicated, Major Events are open to Full Playing and Junior members of the Club with a Golf Australia Men's handicap.

Full details of the conditions of each Major Event are set out in the Golf Competition Manual, which can be viewed in the Member section of the website.

Qualifying Rounds

Where the format of a Major Event includes a qualifying round(s), each Member who wishes to qualify for the subsequent rounds or matches, must sign a qualifying sheet located in the Pro-shop before the start of the round.

Play-Offs

If a tie for first place in a Major Event is to be decided by a Play-off, it will normally be a three (3) hole play-off over the 1st, 8th and 9th holes, unless decided otherwise by the Golf Committee. The player(s) with the lowest score over the three (3) play-off holes will be declared the winner. See the Golf Competition Manual for further details.

Club Championships

A, A Reserve, B and C Grades 72 holes of stroke play. There will be a cut after 36 holes, with the 12 players with the lowest scratch scores in each grade to qualify for the final 36 holes. A tie for last qualifying place(s) will be decided on a count-back. A tie for 1st place will be decided by a play-off.

Junior Boys Championship

54 holes of stroke play. A tie for the last qualifying place(s) will be decided on a countback. A tie for 1st place will be decided by a play-off.

Match Play Championships

A, A Reserve, B and C Grades *Qualifying*: 18 holes of stroke play. The 8 players with the lowest scratch scores in the qualifying round in each grade will qualify for the match play section. A tie for the last qualifying place(s) will be decided on a count-back *Match Play section*: Matches are played without the benefit of handicap in a knockout format until a winner is decided.

Foursomes Championships

A, B and C Grades 36 holes of Foursomes stroke play. There will be a cut after 18 holes, with the 9 pairs with the lowest scratch scores in each grade, qualifying for the final 18 holes. A tie for the last qualifying place(s) will be decided on a countback A tie for 1st place will be decided by a play-off.

Mixed Foursomes Championship

Open to mixed pairs 36 holes of Foursomes stroke play. There will be a cut after 18 holes. The 12 pairs with the lowest scratch scores will qualify for the final 18 holes. A tie for the last qualifying place(s) will be decided on a countback. A tie for 1st place will be decided by a play-off.

North Ryde Amateur Cup

18 holes of stroke play. Open to Members with a Daily Handicap of 8 or less and visitors with a Daily Handicap of 6 or less. The winner will be the player with the lowest scratch score. A tie for 1st place will be decided by a playoff. Members competing in the Amateur Cup are ineligible to compete in the Amateur Bowl.

North Ryde Amateur Bowl

18 holes of stroke play. Members competing in the Amateur Bowl are ineligible to compete in the Amateur Cup. The Member with the lowest nett score will be the winner. A tie for 1st place will be decided on a count-back.

Medal of Medals

Members who have won a Monthly Medal during the previous year will be eligible to contest this event. The eligible player with the lowest nett score will be declared the winner. A tie for 1st place will be decided on a count-back.

Stan Sheather Bowl

Individual Handicap Match Play. *Qualifying:* 18 holes of stroke play. The 32 players with the lowest nett scores qualify for the match play section. A tie for the last qualifying place(s) will be decided on a count-back. *Match Play Section:* Matches are played with the benefit of handicap in a knockout format until a winner is decided. The player with the lowest handicap plays off scratch and the other player plays off the full handicap difference. Players receive shots in accordance with the match play index. A hole is won by the player with the lowest nett score.

Gear Cup

4BBB Handicap Match Play. *Qualifying:* 18 holes of stroke play. The 16 pairs with the lowest aggregate nett scores qualify for the match play section. A tie for the last qualifying place(s) will be decided on a count-back. *Match Play Section:* Matches are played with the benefit of handicap in a knockout format until a winner is decided. The player with the lowest handicap plays off scratch with the other players playing off the full handicap difference. Players receive shots in accordance with the match play index. A hole is won by the side with the lowest nett score.

Seniors' Cup

18 holes of stableford. Open to eligible members who have reached 55 years of age. The winner of the Seniors' Cup is the eligible player with the best stableford score. A tie for 1st place will be decided on a count-back. The winner of the Seniors Cup may also win the daily event.

Veterans' Trophy

18 holes of stableford. Open to eligible members who have reached 65 years of age. The winner of the Veterans' Trophy is the eligible player with the best stableford score. A tie for 1st place will be decided on a count-back. The winner of the Veterans' Trophy may also win the daily event.

Veterans' Championships

36 holes of stroke play. Open to eligible members who have reached 55 years of age. The winner is the player with the lowest scratch score. A tie for 1st place will be decided on a countback.

Commemoration Cup

18 holes of stroke play. The winner is the player with the best stableford points. A tie for 1st place will be decided on a count-back.

Captain's Trophy and President's Trophy

18 holes of stableford. The winner is the best stableford score. A tie for 1st place will be decided on a count-back.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

STANDARD COMPETITIONS

Stroke

The number of strokes taken at each hole is entered on the scorecard and the scores totalled. The player with the lowest score (scratch or nett, depending on the competition) is the winner.

Stableford

Stableford can be played as an individual or team competition. Players are allocated points on each hole depending on their nett score. The player, or team, with the highest number of stableford points is the winner.

Stableford points are allocated as follows for nett scores (after deducting the handicap strokes received on each hole):

- Nett Double Bogey or worse - 0 points
- Nett Bogey - 1 point
- Nett Par - 2 points
- Nett Birdie - 3 points
- Nett Eagle - 4 points
- Nett Albatross - 5 points

2BBB (2 Ball Better Ball) Stableford

In 2BBB Stableford competitions, two players play as partners. The best score on each hole is used to calculate the 2BBB score. The MiClub scoring system calculates the 2BBB score when team and individual events are played in conjunction. The team with the most points is the winner.

2 Ball Aggregate

Team of two players. The stableford scores for each hole are aggregated and count towards the team score. The team with the most points is the winner.

2 Ball Multiplier

Team of two players. Multiply the individual Stableford scores of both players together, to calculate the team score for each hole. The team with the most points is the winner.

Best 3 out of 4

Team of four players. The best three Stableford scores for each hole are aggregated and count towards the team's score. The team with the most points is the winner.

Irish Team Stableford

Team of 4 players. The following scores count:

- For the first 6 holes (1 - 6), the best Stableford score;
- For the next 6 holes (7 - 12), the best 2 scores count;
- For the next 6 holes (13 - 18), the best 3 scores count; The team with the most points is the winner.

Ambrose

Played with teams of two or four players. All players in the team tee-off. The best tee shot is selected. All players drop their ball within one club-length of the selected ball and hit their next stroke. This continues until the ball is on the green. On the green, players place their ball within 15 centimetres of the selected ball. When on the green, players putt out unless the existing score cannot be beaten. Handicaps are $\frac{1}{2}$ of the combined handicaps for four players and $\frac{1}{4}$ of the combined handicaps for two players. Note: An additional rule requiring a minimum number of tee shots of each player to be used may be put in place by the Golf Committee.

Par

Par is played using a similar system to Stableford, with handicap strokes allocated to each hole. **The score at each hole must be entered on the scorecard and the Par score entered in the Result column.** In calculating the Par score, any handicap stroke(s) are deducted.

If the nett score is equal to the par of the hole (2 points in stableford) the result for the hole is a "Square" and a "O" or "□" is entered into the result column. If the nett score is lower than par (3 points or better in stableford), the result is a "Plus" and a "+" is entered into the result column. If the nett score is greater than the par of the hole the result is a "minus" and a "-" is entered into the result column.

At the end of the round, the "pluses" and "minuses" are added up with the nett result being so many "UP", "DOWN" or "ALL SQUARE".

Foursomes

Foursomes is played as a stroke event with a partner and using only one ball. Players hit off alternate tees and play alternate shots until the ball is holed. Penalties do not alter the order of play. Handicaps are $\frac{1}{2}$ of the combined handicaps. The team with the lowest score (scratch or nett, depending on the competition) are the winners.

Medley Competitions

A medley competition is a competition in which both men and women may compete. A medley competition may be any combination of male and female golfers in one group.

Waltz Team Event

Four (4) players per team, teams of three (3) are accepted.

Scores are calculated by taking the team's best individual score on 1st hole, best two scores on 2nd hole, best three scores on 3rd hole, then back to best score on 4th hole, best two scores on 5th hole and so on (ie Waltz= 1-2-3-1- 2-3-etc). The team having the highest number of points at the end of the round is the winner.

Wednesday Competitions

1st Wednesday of each month – 2BBB and Individual Stableford (Cross over).

2nd Wednesday of each month – 2 Ball Aggregate and Individual Stableford.

3rd Wednesday of each month – Best 3 out of 4, 2 Ball and Individual Stableford.

4th Wednesday of each odd month (January, March, May, July, September, November 2025) Irish Team Event and Single Stableford.

4th Wednesday of each even month (February, April, June, August, October, December 2025) Waltz Team Event and Single Stableford.

5th Wednesday (March, September, December 2025) – Wednesday Challenge.

Veterans

Veterans' competitions are open to eligible playing members who have attained the age of 55 years.

The Veterans' competitions are held on the 2nd, 4th and 5th Mondays of each month, except Public and Bank Holidays or when the Club is hosting a special event, or the Club's bi-annual Course Renovations have been scheduled. Tee-times are between 7:00am and 10:00am.

Mobile Phones

If a mobile phone is carried by a Member on the golf course it must be set to silent mode, even when used for scoring. The use of a mobile phone to make or receive calls on the golf course, may be distracting and inconsiderate to other competitors. Accordingly, the use of a mobile phone to make or receive calls during a competition is discouraged but acceptable for scoring. The use of a mobile phone on the golf course for any purpose must not interfere with the enjoyment of other golfers or disrupt or slow down play.

Members are reminded that under the Rules of Golf:

- If a player commits a serious breach of etiquette, he or she may be disqualified under Rule 33-7. A breach of this By-Law may be considered a serious breach of etiquette.
- A player may use an electronic device to measure distance, provided the device is not used to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. elevation changes or wind speed, etc).

Protests

Any complaint or protest about a match or competition must be lodged to the Duty Director no later than fifteen (15) minutes after the last cards have been handed in.

The Golf Committee reserves the right to make any variation to any event listed in this fixture book.
